## **RE: Request for Additional Election Day Workers at Voting Precinct 2 in Foggy Bottom**

Dear Ms. Miller,

At its regular meeting on July 20, 2016, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “**Commission**”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of seven commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to adopt the following resolution, which was introduced by Commissioner Zhurbinskiy and seconded by Commissioner Smith, by a vote of **(7-0-0)**:

WHEREAS, ANC 2A is home to the George Washington University’s (GW) Foggy Bottom campus,

WHEREAS, the student population at GW has grown over the past four years,

WHEREAS, presidential election years have high voter turnout, and college students are particularly likely to take advantage of same-day voter registration, and

WHEREAS, during the 2012 election, so many GW students registered to vote on the day of the election that there were not enough election day workers to process same-day voter registrations in an efficient manner, resulting in long lines.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2A asks the DC Board of Elections to dispatch one additional special ballot clerk, one additional check-in clerk, and one additional ballot clerk over previous years’ levels at voting precinct 2 in Foggy Bottom in order to ensure an efficient and quick voting process for Foggy Bottom residents.
