RE: Application by the Park Hyatt Hotel at 1201 24th Street NW to Bring the Establishment’s Summer Garden into Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration Compliance (ABRA-096399)

Dear Chairperson Anderson,

At its regular meeting on May 16, 2018, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of seven commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission unanimously voted (7-0-0), after a motion made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Kennedy, to adopt the following resolution:

As the Park Hyatt Hotel has operated a 54 seat summer garden at the northeast corner of 24th Street and M Street NW for several decades without complaint or objection from the community, ANC 2A respectfully informs the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board that, in the view of the ANC, formal ABC Board approval of such summer garden is not potentially of concern to the residents or businesses surrounding the Park Hyatt Hotel.
