At its regular meeting on September 16, 2020, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With four of six commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously (4-0-0), after a motion made by Commissioner Harnett and seconded by Commissioner Kennedy, to adopt the following resolution:

ANC 2A supports Boston Properties’ request for an extension of their after-hours permit until October 31st, 2020 as part of the 2100 Pennsylvania Avenue NW construction project. The ANC also supports Boston Properties’ request to work on Indigenous Peoples’ Day on October 12th, 2020 as part of the project.
