At its regular meeting on November 20, 2019, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously (7-0-0), after a motion made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Kennedy, to adopt the following resolution:

ANC 2A supports WashREIT’s request for an after-hours permit to work on several upcoming nights and weekends as part of the 600 New Hampshire Avenue NW construction project, contingent upon an expression of support from either the manager or the Board of Directors of the Watergate South building at 700 New Hampshire Avenue NW.
