RE: Application by Squash on Fire to Transfer the Applicant’s Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant License to a New Location at 2233 M Street NW (ABRA-105808)

Dear Chairperson Anderson,

At its regular meeting on April 19, 2017, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously (7-0-0), after a motion made by Commissioner Harmon and seconded by Commissioner Smith, to adopt the following resolution:

ANC 2A supports Squash on Fire’s application to transfer the applicant’s Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant license to a new location at 2233 M Street NW based on the applicant’s amendment to its application to specify that the establishment’s summer garden will close at 11:00 pm on Sunday through Thursday and at 12:00 am on Friday through Saturday.

ANC 2A also supports the applicant’s request to amend its application to allow the interior of the establishment to close at 2:00 am on Sunday through Thursday and at 3:00 am on Friday through Saturday.
