RE: District Department of Transportation Proposal to Install a Capital Bikeshare Station Near 22nd Street and C Street NW

Dear Ms. Lucas,

At its regular meeting on April 20, 2016, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With six of seven commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to adopt the following resolution, which was introduced by Commissioner Kennedy and seconded by Commissioner Smith, by a vote of (5-0-0*):

ANC 2A supports the concept of adding additional Capital Bikeshare stations to the area near the intersection of Constitution Avenue and 22nd Street NW, and requests that the District Department of Transportation work with all stakeholders in the area, including the ANC, to identify the best location for this station.
