Dear Chairperson Miller,

At its regular meeting on February 19, 2015, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“**ANC 2A**” or “**Commission**”) considered the above-referenced matter. With all eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted to approve the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

ANC 2A withdraws its previously-filed protest of this license application, based on the Applicant agreeing to reduce the proposed hours of alcohol sales/service/consumption to no later than 11 p.m. from Sunday through Thursday and 12 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

In addition, the Commission supports the granting of a stipulated license so that the Applicant may begin alcohol sales and service immediately, under the proposed license terms.
