RE: Public Space Application by Whole Foods Market to Add Umbrellas to the Establishment’s Existing Sidewalk Café (2201 I Street NW; Tracking No. 10232982)

Dear Chairperson Marcou,

At its regular meeting on May 18, 2016, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With six of seven commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously (5-0-0), after a motion made by Commissioner Kennedy and seconded by Commissioner Williams, to raise no objection to the public space application by Whole Foods Market to add umbrellas to the establishment’s existing sidewalk café.

The ANC only received DDOT permit information for another public space application at this location (DDOT #10235386), which contemplated the use of different and more extensive furniture and fixtures, that the applicant indicated is no longer operative. Therefore, the ANC's position on this matter extends only to the concept outlined above that is associated with the referenced tracking number (DDOT #10232982).
