Dear Chairperson Marcou,

At its regular meeting on April 20, 2016, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With six of seven commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously (6-0-0), after a motion made by Commissioner Harmon and seconded by Commissioner Kennedy, to conditionally raise no objection to the Washington Marriott Georgetown’s public space application, provided that the hotel operator come to an agreement with the ANC and nearby residents regarding the hotel’s operations for the outdoor function terrace, including the terms of any substantial changes to the hotel’s Alcoholic Beverage Control Board license that the hotel might seek.
