RE: Safety and Services for Homeless Individuals During Extended Cold Weather

Dear Director Zeilinger,

At its regular meeting on January 17, 2018, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of seven commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to adopt the following resolution, which was introduced by Commissioner Kennedy and seconded by Commissioner Schrefer, by a vote of (7-0-0):

ANC 2A requests that the Department of Human Services provide to the ANC the prerequisites and additional factors involved in the opening of a warming center for homeless individuals in DC, specifically with regards to the process for opening a warming center in the Foggy Bottom and West End neighborhood.
