RE: Public Space Permit Filing by Boston Properties for Streetscape Improvements Along 26th Street Between I Street and K Street NW (DDOT #312840)

At its regular meeting on May 16, 2018, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of seven commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission unanimously voted (7-0-0), after a motion made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Campbell, to adopt the following resolution:

ANC 2A expresses its support to the District Department of Transportation for Boston Properties’ permit filing (DDOT #312840) for streetscape improvements along 26th Street between I Street and K Street NW, which include the installation of a sidewalk on the west side of the street, the installation of a crosswalk, modifications to the wall along the adjacent park, and the installation of a water fountain.
