**RE: The American Red Cross’ Public Space Application to Relocate the Sculpture Located at the Intersection of 20th Street and E Street NW to the Intersection of 18th Street and E Street NW (DDOT #205258)**

Dear Chair Marcou,

At its regular meeting on July 19, 2017, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With eight of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted unanimously (7-0-0\*), after a motion made by Commissioner Kennedy and seconded by Commissioner Smith, to raise no objection to the American Red Cross’ public space application to relocate the sculpture located at the intersection of 20th Street and E Street NW to the intersection of 18th Street and E Street NW.

The Commission further requests that a representative for the American Red Cross attend an upcoming regular ANC 2A meeting to discuss the organization’s decision to sell its headquarters building at 2025 E Street NW and the organization’s resulting abdication of its previous formal commitments to the neighborhood to maintain the public spaces surrounding its former headquarters building.
