At its regular meeting on March 19, 2014, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A ("ANC 2A" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With five of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (5-0):

ANC 2A withdraws its standing protest of this license application, as transmitted in a letter dated February 24, 2014, with the understanding that the application has been amended to reflect new proposed hours of operation and hours of alcoholic beverage sales/service/consumption on the establishment's sidewalk café as follows:

Hours of operation: 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Sunday through Thursday; and 7 a.m. to 12 a.m., Friday and Saturday

Hours of alcoholic beverage sales/service/consumption: 8 a.m. to 11 p.m., Sunday through Thursday; and 8 a.m. to 12 a.m., Friday and Saturday
