



# Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A

*“Serving the Foggy Bottom and West End communities of Washington, D.C.”*

June 15, 2015

At its regular meeting on May 20, 2015, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“**ANC 2A**” or “**Commission**”) voted to adopt the following resolution by a vote of **(6-0-0)**, acting with a quorum of six out of seven commissioners present:

WHEREAS 2<sup>nd</sup> District Lieutenant Donald Craig served with distinction the District of Columbia Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) for over twenty-five years;

WHEREAS Lieutenant Donald Craig served with distinction as MPD Lieutenant of the 2<sup>nd</sup> District for over three years:

WHEREAS Lieutenant Craig defended the interests of the West End and Foggy Bottom Communities in numerous ways, including but not limited to, diligently addressing public safety concerns through providing MPD staffing and resources for ANC 2A ABRA protests, crime investigations, traffic flow and DDOT assistance, community policing meetings, and addressing many other concerns raised by West End and Foggy Bottom representatives;

WHEREAS Lieutenant Craig took the initiative to personally contact ANC Commissioners and other community representatives on numerous occasions, many times after hours and on weekends, to apprise them of information of which they should be aware to address public safety matters;

WHEREAS Lieutenant Craig is an exemplary public servant, who served with distinction, throughout his tenure at MPD, with principled opinions and a keen sense of the Foggy Bottom and West End neighborhood residential perspective;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in recognition of Lieutenant Donald Craig’s twenty-five years of service on MPD, the Commissioner hereby extends to him its grateful appreciation and best wishes for the years to come.
