At its regular meeting on May 19, 2022, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With six of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted (5-0-1), after a motion made by Commissioner Barbisch and seconded by Commissioner Hudson, to adopt the following resolution:

ANC 2A protests The Nixon Lounge’s application for a new Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant license at 2600 Virginia Avenue NW based on the adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood. The ANC agrees to drop the protest if and when an acceptable settlement agreement is signed by the applicant and ANC 2A.
