At its regular meeting on January 15, 2014, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A ("ANC 2A" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With six of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission by unanimous consent elected to re-consider its motion in support of the alley reconfiguration originally approved on September 18, 2013. It adopted the following resolution by a vote of (5-0)ⁱ:
